Our company will install a Solahart, closed-loop, thermo-siphon solar hot water system.

- This system is maintenance-free and long-lived. It relies upon basic physics to operate.
- The Solahart system uses the sun’s heat and the earth’s gravity with no need for complicated and troublesome parasitic equipment such as pumps, pump controllers and freeze-protection bleed valves.
- The Solahart system cannot freeze because it uses potable (non-toxic) antifreeze to transfer the sun’s heat into your hot water storage tank.
- The equipment to be installed includes the following items:
 - Horizontal, roof-mounted, tank
 - 2 each roof mounted solar collectors
 - Bracing, plumbing, electrical, and general construction materials and labor as necessary to ensure a well-functioning, solar hot water system.

Payment – the above job will cost \$6,667.00.
